

Middle School Progression (New Student Information)

We expect all students and families to understand the course progression at the Math & Science Academy and the rigor that goes along with these classes. Your child will receive several hours of homework each week for most of the classes listed below.

Art

One semester of Art is required during middle school. Students are scheduled for Art in $8^{\mbox{th}}$ grade.

English

Students must complete the following English classes:

- English 6 (6th grade) 1 year
- English 7 (7th grade) 1 year
- English 8 (8th grade) 1 year

Health

One semester of Health is required during middle school. Students are scheduled for Health in 7^{th} grade.

Math

Middle school students may be at a different level in math. Students must complete one full year of math with a passing grade before moving to the next class. Below is a typical progression during middle school:

- Middle School 1 (6th grade) 1 year
- Middle School 2 (6th or 7th grade) 1 year
- Integrated I (6th, 7th, or 8th grade) 1year
- Integrated II (7th or 8th grade) 1 year
- Integrated III (8th grade) 1 year

Spanish

Students must have the following progression:

- MS Spanish IA (6th Grade) 1 year
- MS Spanish IB (7th Grade) 1 year
- HS Spanish I (8th Grade) 1 year

Science

Students must have the following progression of middle school science classes:

- Life Science (6th grade) 1 year
- Earth Science (7th grade) 1 year
- Physical Science (8th grade) 1 year MSA's Physical Science course is the equivalent of a high school Physical Science course.
